ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- **Domestic students** must be Australian Citizens, Permanent Residents, or New Zealand Citizens.
- Students must be over 18 years old.
- Students must meet an English level of IELTS 5.5 or above. This is exempt if students are planning to do the Online Foundation English course
- **Other Visa Holders:** Applicants with other Australian visas must have valid study entitlements.
- **Important Note:** These courses are not CRICOS-registered. We cannot accept applications from Student Visa (subclass 500) holders or provide documentation for Student Visa applications.
